Code of Conduct – Competition

As a member of Denmark Gymnastics, all persons are required to comply with the following Competition Codes of Conduct.

Athletes

- Listen to your Coach, Judges and GWA staff attentively.
- Follow instructions provided.
- Running around competition floor and using equipment without permission will not be tolerated.
- Keep the gym clean and tidy.
- Walk appropriately between apparatus stations.
- Be responsible for your own equipment bags, tapes, leotard, grips etc.
- Always show a positive attitude.
- Be respectful of all persons including: other parents, clubs, gymnasts, GWA staff, judges and coaches. Remember that you represent Denmark Gymnastics.
- Conduct yourself appropriately on the award podium smile!
- Make every effort to not only support your own team mates but all competing individuals from other gyms.
- Thank the judges, award presenters, coaches and parents.
- Clap for other award recipients not just your own team mates.
- Remember to have fun we are all so proud of you!

Parent/Guardian/Spectator

- Under no circumstances are parents permitted to enter the competition arena or speak or signal to the gymnasts or coach during the competition.
- Parents must not question any judges or GWA staff regarding their child's score or performance at any competition or event.
- Show appreciation for ALL gymnasts' performances including from other clubs.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- Only take photos/recording of your own child be aware of GWA's policy regarding photography of participants.
- Refrain from making any negative comments about a gymnast's performance, ability, leotard or physical appearance.
- Refrain from any harassment of others.
